

Frequently Asked Questions about Impact Aid

1. Why is it important to return the School Impact Aid survey?

Impact Aid is a federal program that provides financial resources to schools impacted by federally-owned, tax-exempt properties in the military and other communities. These funds become part of our District's operating budget and are critical to helping us forward academic excellence. The information you provide is confidential and will help us better serve our students.

2. What sections do I fill out if Parent/Guardian is a Civilian not working or living on Federal Property?

Simply fill out two sections on the survey form:

- Place a check in the box at the top of form
- Print and sign your name, and date at the bottom of the form.

3. What sections do I fill out if Parent/Guardian is Active Duty Military?

Simply fill out three sections on the survey form:

- Student information
- Parent/Guardian Employment Information: Uniformed Service.
- Print and sign your name, and date at the bottom of the form.
- National Guard or Reserves count IF you have been mobilized under Presidential Executive Order 13223 as of 9/14/2001 and Title 10 USC (attach copy of activation orders)

4. What sections do I fill out if Parent/Guardian is Foreign Military?

Simply fill out three sections on the survey form:

- Student Information
- Parent/Guardian Employment Information: Foreign Military
- Print and sign your name, and date at the bottom of the form.

5. What sections do I fill out if Parent/Guardian is a Civilian working on Federal Property?

Simply fill out three sections on the survey form:

- Student information
- Parent/Guardian Employment Information: Civilian
- Print and sign your name, and date at the bottom of the form.

Many of our parent/guardians are employed on federal property on the military installations. Please list that parent/guardian. Employer address AND address of federal property are required. Thank you for signing and dating the bottom of the survey form as well!

6. Why Do I need to sign and date the bottom of the survey card?

By signing the form, you are certifying that all typed (student label at the top) and written information is accurate and complete as of the survey date September 4, 2019.

7. Is all my given information confidential?

YES! All survey forms are kept here in the school district and information is used for categorization purposes only. The Impact Aid Program requires that we just submit numbers of students to the federal government, not information.
